The Local Sporting Champions Program is a government initiative which aims to financially support young athletes and teams with the significant costs associated with their sporting commitments including travel, accommodation, uniforms and sporting equipment. This assistance can only be given to athletes competing in a national sporting competition. There is specific criteria that you must meet in order to be eligible for this funding which includes being:

- Aged between 12-18 yrs (inclusive)
- Required to travel at least 250km return to compete in the competition
- An Australian Citizen
